Coaches Code of Conduct

- Coaches will always be fair and consistent.
- Coaches will promote a positive attitude and lead by example.
- Coaches will stress teamwork and respect of each other and lead by example.
- Coaches will listen to players/parents concerns.
- Coaches will avoid the use of profanity, drugs, alcohol, and tobacco during all ARSYAA events.
- Coaches will allow each athlete the opportunity to compete and excel to his/her ability.
- Coaches will allow each athlete the opportunity to play the required playtime at a minimum.
- Coaches will follow all ARSYAA by-laws and rules as well as all league and sport rules.
- Coaches will exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
- Coaches will take precautions to ensure participant safety.
- Coaches will not engage in violent conduct or verbal abuse toward any player, parent, coach, referee, spectator at any ARSYAA game, practices, or event.
- Coaches will respect the calls of the officials/referees.
- Coaches will wait 24 hours before addressing any significant concern or issue with a parent or player.
- Coaches will adhere to the No-Tolerance Policy and/or Code of Conduct Policies established by the leagues in which we play.
- Any coach violating the code of conduct, rules, or policies/procedures of ARSYAA or the league in which we play may be suspended or denied participation in future sports.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- Parents will support the efforts of the coaches, coordinators, participants and other involved with ARSYAA sports.
- Parents will exhibit good sportsmanship and expect this of their child.
- Parents will not argue with coach, referee/official at any ARSYAA event.
- Parents will avoid the use of profanity, drugs, alcohol, and tobacco during all ARSYAA events.
- Parents will remain on the sidelines and/or designated areas during all games and practices.
- Parents will wait 24 hours to before addressing any significant concerns or issues arising from a game with a coach.
- Parents will not engage in violent conduct or verbal abuse toward any player, parent, coach, referee, spectator at any ARSYAA game, practices, or event.
- Parents will respect the calls of the officials/referees.
- Parents will praise players efforts and offer support.
- Parents will adhere to the No-Tolerance Policy and/or Code of Conduct Policies established by the leagues in which we play.
- Parents will advise all family members and visitors of the expectations and encourage their adherence as well.
- Any parent violating the code of conduct or policies/procedures of ARSYAA or the league in which we play may be suspended or denied participation in future sports.

Player Code of Conduct

- Players will try their best and support their team.
- Players will be team players and put their team first.
- Players will stay in designated team areas during games and practices.
- Players will listen to and respect coaches.
- Players will be ready to learn and have fun.
- Players will follow all ARSYAA and league rules.
- Players will demonstrate good sportsmanship on and off the field.
- Players will attend and be on time for all practices, games, meetings, and any other team function.
- Players will not engage in violent conduct, verbal abuse, or the use of profanity toward any player, parent, coach, referee, spectator at any ARSYAA game, practices, or event.
- Players will respect the calls of the official/referee.
- Players violating the code of conduct or policies/procedures of ARSYAA or the league in which we play may be suspended or denied participation in future sports.
